Through Home Services, Golden Valley Memorial Healthcare offers three distinct ways to receive these services: Home Health, Home Care, and Custom Care.

Home Health

Our professional staff of nurses and therapists provide physician directed health services.

Home Health is covered by Medicare, Medicaid and most insurance companies when care is ordered by a physician.

These services include:

- Skilled Nursing—A nurse assesses and teaches the patient and family how to care for the patient. The nurse also carries out specific treatments.
- Home Health Aide—Under supervision of a registered nurse, the aide provides personal care and appropriate household chores.

- Mom/Baby and Pediatric Nursing—Providing education to promote a healthy pregnancy and a healthy childbirth experience. We provide care for high risk moms and newborn care if complications arise, as well as medical follow-up of children birth to 18.
- Physical Therapy—A physical therapist provides transfer and gait training, evaluation of home safety, equipment needs, therapeutic exercise and education to improve activity.
- Occupational Therapy—An occupational therapist provides home assessment, teaching and education to assist in regaining independence, therapeutic exercises, and assistive equipment.
- Speech Therapy—Our speech pathologist provides in-home consultation, evaluations and therapy to assist with swallowing, speech, comprehension, thinking and memory.
- Medical Social Services—A Medical Social Worker provides information about community services and resources that will support you in your home, counseling and support in relation to your illness or lifestyle changes, assistance with medical/legal issues such as Advanced Health Care Directives, and helps with concerns and questions regarding finances/insurance.

Home Health covers all of Henry and Benton counties, eastern Cass and Bates counties, southern parts of Johnson and Pettis and northern parts of St. Clair county.

Home Care

Nurses and aides provide in-home care services to meet your individual needs. Home care allows you to receive personal care in your home as well as medically related household tasks. Other services include medication management, foot care, self-care education, and respite. Home Care covers all of Henry County.

Home Care is covered by Medicaid, Care Connection, authorized VA and other entities when approved by a case manager.

Custom Care

Custom Care allows you to get the services you may need even when you may not qualify for other programs. Private insurance may pay for this type of care. Services include nursing, homemaker, and lab draw services. Your care is supervised by a nurse. Custom Care covers all of Henry and Benton counties, eastern Cass and Bates counties and southern parts of Johnson and Pettis.
